Step 1 - Application

Visit saoic.org/apply to complete your online application. Your Admissions Counselor will reach out to you within 1–3 business days.

Step 2 - Placement Test

Schedule a Placement Test. The test lets us evaluate your current knowledge so we can best help you. Study materials are available to download to help you prepare. You can take the test multiple times.

Step 3 - Complete FAFSA

Complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and meet with a Financial Aid coordinator.

Step 4 - Meet with your Admissions Team

Schedule to meet with both your Admissions Counselor and Financial Aid Counselor. They will walk you through completing your aid, as well as collecting all necessary documents for enrollment at Summit Academy.

Step 5 - New Student Orientation

Meet staff and other students. Receive all materials, your student ID, and learn about Summit policies and procedures.
