

IT Career Pathway at RAHS



At Roseville Area High School, students can take the following courses in the IT Pathway:

- Intro to Computer Science and Coding
- Website Design (articulated with Saint Paul College)
- Microsoft Office Computer Applications
- Computer Fundamentals
- Keyboarding for Employment
- AP Computer Science Principles
- AP Computer Science with Java

- Software Developers
- Information Security Analysts
- Computer Systems Analysts
- Software Quality Assurance Analysts
- Computer Network Support Specialists

These are careers that young people may want to look into, as the job market is very open for these positions; many of the classes students can take at RAHS can provide exposure and foundational information for these careers as well.
