






COVID-19 Has Disproportionate Employment Impacts on Ramsey County Residents





- Pre-COVID-19 % of Labor Force
- % of Total COVID-19 UI Applicants through May 7, 2021
- BIPOC = Black, Indigenous, and People of Color
- Labor Force = People who are willing and able to work, including all working and unemployed residents
- 135,254 unemployment applications filed in Ramsey County from March 16 through May 7, 2021
- Percentages on each metric have remained mostly stable since the Summer of 2020.



Opportunity: Host A Part Time Intern

- Interns are 18 to 24 year old Ramsey County residents.
- Host an intern for 15 weeks from August 9 to November 19, 2021.
- Intern work 20 hours per week, \$15/hour
- ALL wages and payroll covered by Ramsey County
- Learn how to support young, diverse employees
- All interns will receive ongoing support from a community-based organization



Roles and Responsibilities

County/City	Community Based Organization (CBO)	Employer
 Overall funding for the program including providing payroll and funding for interns. Leading a community leadership group consisting of CBOs to ensure program is running well. 	 Enroll participants. Consult with and participate in internship matching. Provide case management. Support participants with completing requirements for payroll for the internship. Provide support services for participants. Provide a community mentor. Require and track young adult participants to complete professional development activities. 	 Plan internship experience and host. Providing opportunities to learn and explore careers in industry while working Assign lead contact person/supervisor. Attend supervisory training by Irreducible Grace Foundation. Confirm time worked and communicate with community-based organization as needed.



FAQ

How is this program different then Right Track?

Right Track Plus is developed to serve young adults, ages 18-24, with interns that will open doors into career pathways, not just develop work readiness skills.

What happens if an issue arises with intern?

The organizations supporting the interns will be able to come on site and work with everyone to resolve issues. If issue cannot be resolved, employer can dismiss intern.

Will Ramsey County and/or the City of Saint Paul do background checks, drug tests, etc.?

No. If your organization requires these pieces, please communicate that in your sign up. Your organization will be responsible for those items, if requested.

Who is responsible for worker's compensation?

The employer of record, either Ramsey County or City of Saint Paul, is responsible for the worker's compensation. All internship supervisors will be trained on first report of injury.

If I want to host multiple interns, do I need to fill out the form multiple times?

Yes, unless the interns are going to be identical. If that is the case, please indicate that and how many you'd like to host in "Additional Comments" section.
